Meeting on April 10, 2026

The meeting was called to order by the Treasurer at 8:00 pm.

Swore in new members (Brian Mitchel Jr)

Gary read the minutes and they were accepted

Brian Hackert was voted back in as director after missing many meetings.

1st Vice Commodore's Report- Brian read BJ's report of March 2026 had a drawer value of \$6,793.57 with no known error and a deposit of \$1,539.19. This was an increase over March of last year by \$591.95. The dishwasher, including the electric elements, have been cleaned as much as possible with vinegar over the course of three days and seems to be working as it should. A new cooler is in and running great. The old cooler is on the back deck and needs to go.

2nd Vice Commodore's Report- Gary reported for John Trivia night was a lot of fun. The turnout was great for Amanda and Raul who did a great job for their first time at the club. On April 18th, Bobby Badfinger Motyl will be playing at the club from 7 to 10. Hoping to have some kind of food for that night.

May 2nd is Pizza Night. Pizza will be served from 5 to 7 p.m. Fas4ward will be playing from 7:30 to 10:30.

June 27th is now Shipwrecked night instead of Neon night.

Rear Commodore report- Karl reported there will be work parties April 11, 12, 18, and 19 starting at 8 am. There is a lot of work that needs to be done before the docks open.

Treasurer report- Lori reported on the monthly bills. Lori reported the club had a total revenue of \$10,783 which includes membership dues, docks, assessments, house income including bar and fuels sales. Expenses totaled \$47,676 leaving a net year to date profit of \$94,420 at the end of March. All Bills have been paid to date.

Purser Report- Tonya reported no deposits for the month of March. Our annual Pizza party is coming up on May 2nd. If you are available to help and would like work hours, please let Tonya know. Also let Tonya know if you would like to donate desserts for that night.

Director's Report
